## APPEARANCE

Pale straw with a fine, sparkling bead.

## BOUQUET

Lifted citrus blossom and fresh leaf mixed with lemon sorbet and hints of nectarine and mandarin.

## PALATE

A crisp and refreshing mix of lemon, lime, grapefruit and white nectarine flavours leading into a soft and fleshy mid palate of honeydew, green apple and lemon sorbet. The focussed acidity combined with the voluminous mouth-feel finish the wine with crispness, persistence and length.

## WINEMAKING

A blend of white varieties that reflect all that is desirable from McLaren Vale's climate and soils. Comprising of 55% Vermentino, 23% Verdelho, 22% Sauvignon Blanc, the wine is a crisp yet refreshing and flavoursome style designed to suit our Aussie summer lifestyle.

Cool fermented with aromatic and fruit flavor preservation in mind the Vermentino's crisp, structural and vibrant contribution is filled out by the Verdelho's rich, tropical mid palate and yeasty lees stirred characteristics, while the Sauvignon Blanc twist gives the aromatics a lift and provides a herbaceous edge.
