



2015 SAUVIGNON BLANC

APPEARANCE

Pale gold.

BOUQUET

Classically varietal nose with leafy aromas of lantana, citrus blossom, kaffir lime and lemon with hints of golden peach and pineapple.

PALATE

Green herbs, pineapple, golden peach and orange characters fill a luscious and juicy mid palate, these flavours persist in the mouth before finishing with lemon zest and crisp balanced acid.

WINEMAKING

Harvest occurred on both February 2 and 5 for the older and younger sections respectively of the Fox Creek Cellar Door vineyard. The young vine section contributes the tropical fruit and mid palate weight and the older section provides the herbaceousness, perfume and citrus characteristics.

Cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks for two weeks, with two different yeast strains allowed the grapes to express their natural characters and enhanced the structure of the wine. This wine is suited for early drinking and will retain fresh fruit characters for the next couple of years.
